«Together with his illustrious friend Sisto Favre, Chiesa always stressed the absolute necessity of resuming the 'connection with the arts and literature'. His last venture in this direction was launched shortly before he left us, proposing to create an international art prize guaranteed by the highest cultural authority, the Biennale

# Extract from the Central Board's Report at the Assembly in Rapallo (4-5 June 1994):

Paragraph 6

(...) Panathlon International would be of further service to Olympism if it were also able to establish an International Prize for the Visual Arts.

(...)

The cultural guarantees will have to come from a leading Institution in that field. The hope is that the patronage of a few panathletes will underpin it.





# The patron existed and cherished the dream but wanted to remain anonymous.

When they heard of their relative's wish and in order to honor his memory, the Chiesa family offered a generous bequest with the only clause that Panathlon International should contribute to the endowment of the new foundation with a further sum of at least half. This is the intangible heritage. The Foundation can only use the fruits of the capital investment for its activities and increase it through donations.



## THE BIENNALE 2001

On the 50th anniversary of the foundation of the Panathlon Club Venezia and the panathletic movement,

the International Jury of the 49th Venice Art Biennale awarded, for the first time, the Foundation Prize to the installation (30 panels) "Run for your life" by Urs Lühti from Switzerland, which occupies the entire Swiss Pavilion.

# The 50th anniversary of Panathlon Club Venice and the Panathletic Movement

The ceremony takes place in the "Sala dello Scrutinio" in the Ducal Palace on 12 October 2001. The program includes the presentation of the Flambeaux d'Or Awards and the first edition of the Domenico Chiesa Foundation Prize. Speakers include the President of the Biennale, Prof. Paolo Baratta, and the Director of the Visual Arts sector, Arald Szeeman.





- The idea of the International Graphic Competition was born, initially aimed at high school students with an artistic background.






# INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION OF GRAPHIC ARTS


### 2003

# FROM 2008 TO 2012 the Foundation awarded the Barovièr Cup each year to a debut film at the World Festival of the Fédération Internationale du Cinéma et Télévision Sportifs (FICTS)







2008 – 2013 The same trophy was awarded as Special Prize at the San Marino International Photographic Competition, with the theme "Sport".



#### PANATHLON INTERNATIONAL AT A GLANCE


The purpose of this cultural association, founded in Venice in 1951, is to "deepen, divulge and defend the values of sport as a tool for training and enhancing the individual and as a vehicle of solidarity between men and peoples".

Recognised by the IOC, Panathlon International is present in 25 countries on three continents and has approximately 10,000 members.

#### INTERNATIONAL GRAPHIC ARTS COMPETITION

The "Drawing Sports" anthological exhibition showcases works from 16 editions of the International Graphic Arts Competition – organised by the Domenico Chiesa Cultural Foundation – which recognises graphic-art works inspired by sport.

This competition is a real challenge for students aged 15 to 18: to graphically translate the values they have experienced and the emotions they have felt when practising sport or meeting with champions.

## SUSPENSION OF THE XVIII GRAPHIC COMPETITION

(Decision n. 1/2019 of 19/10/2019)

Although the 182 entries don't represent a low number, the fact that they came from 14 Italian schools and only one school in Chile led the Foundation's Board of Directors to decide to suspend the competition and to consider new proposals for involving schools and the world of Internet users.

The function of 'Ambassadors' was not understood or communicated convincingly. Except in a few cases, where ambassadors made an effort and actually communicated with the Foundation, they were abandoned after a couple of years.


At the October 2019 the Foundation Board meeting decided to ask clubs to nominate one of their Board members to act as a Foundation contact person.





In May 2021, in the year of its 25th birthday, the Foundation entered into a partnership with the Fédération Internationale Cinéma & Télévision Sportifs (FICTS) and launched the VISUAL ART COMPETITION «SPORT AS PROMOTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS»

for short and very short films (max. 4 min.)



The P.I. Clubs are involved in selecting 20 films, from which an International Jury, made up of three members from FICTS and three from the Foundation, choose the three podium winners.



# **PROJECTS 2022**

At its meeting of 25 November 2021, the International Board decided to reintroduce the Visual Art Competition and the creation of a new PHOTO CONTEST project, in collaboration with the Palazzo Magnani Foundation and the Sport Foundation of Reggio Emilia (Italy) within the framework of the 2022 EUROPEAN PHOTOGRAPHY Festival with the theme "An invincible summer".







## **Domenico Chiesa Award**

The award consisting of a gold pin, a parchment and the inscription in the Golden Book was established in 2002 in order to create an honour for special merits in the work of disseminating panathletic ideals and for the support given to Panathlon International and to the Foundation (continued)







A not secondary purpose is to feed the income of the Foundation.

The award is conferred by the President of Panathlon International on motivated request of Clubs (or Areas/Districts) and can also be attributed to people not affiliated to Panathlon. The request must be accompanied by the payment of a contribution of € 600,00.
