Project to award grants for activities to be implemented in 2021

Throughout last year and at least for half of the current year, the activities of Panathlon Clubs worldwide were and are still affected by objective difficulties due to the Covid pandemic.

For our movement, it is essential to take every possible step, at all levels, to counter this downturn in activity.

In order to arouse new interest towards disseminating Panathlon's values, in its meeting held on February 19 the International Board approved a project to provide financial support to the Clubs for their efforts in organising sport-related service activities.

In this framework, the International Board decided to grant:

- 1. A maximum budget of EUR 35,000;**
- 2. Free-of-charge promotional material (various printed material) and gadgets (bookmarks, lapel pins, T-shirts etc.).**

Rules governing the 2020/2021 Covid subsidy

At this difficult time of lockdown, these subsidies result from the willingness to increase the activities of individual Clubs which will implement **service projects pursuing Panathlon's purpose** while also **carrying out their planned events**.

How to apply

Each Club may apply for the financial subsidy or the free-of-charge promotional material by submitting its project or individual planned activities, accompanied by their descriptions and cost estimates, by 30th September 2021 at the latest.

To be eligible for the subsidy, a Club must be in good standing with the annual fees due to PI.

Award of the subsidy

By next October, PI Secretariat will release a summary of the applications received, accompanied by its evaluation, which will be submitted to the PC.

The PC will decide the amounts of the subsidies, such decision being final and indisputable. The subsidies will be settled by the end of November 2021.

Metrics

To define the amount of each subsidy, several metrics will be duly weighted and applied, namely:

- Importance of the project
- Cost of the project
- Amount of the fee-per-Member paid to PI (e.g. EUR 52 – EUR 36 – EUR 18 etc.) and financial situation of the Club
- Number of Members of the Club
